



Objectives

The participants of the course will become familiar with approaches, best practices and successful strategies and techniques to integrate content and language in a bilingual classroom. The aims of the course are:

- ✓ To familiarise participants with examples of good practice in CLIL
- ✓ To increase understanding of the potential of CLIL methodology
- ✓ To provide resources and strategies to adapt subjects to CLIL methodology
- ✓ To encourage ICT as a tool of learning and collaboration
- ✓ To provide a variety of new teaching ideas, practical classroom skills and materials

Target group

This course is designed for school directors, school coordinators, primary and secondary teachers who are applying CLIL in their teaching methodology or are about to start using CLIL to teach a subject in a foreign language.

Methodology

The approach used is highly practical, based on the expertise of the course trainers who have a great experience in innovative teaching strategies. Practical activities and practical simulations will be carried out. Through group work, participants will gain experience in planning CLIL lessons (learners' motivation, communicative skills, materials, expected outcomes, assessment and evaluation) and developing CLIL materials related to different subjects.
