

APPLYING CLIL (CONTENT AND LANGUAGE INTEGRATED LEARNING) METHODOLOGY

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Objectives

The aims of the course are:

- Provide the participants with tools and pieces of advice which could be useful in order to plan a CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning) lesson.
- Provide with general information about CLIL definition and applications.
- Improve how to manage a CLIL lesson: materials, time management, coordination with colleagues.
- Share and exchange previous experiences in CLIL learning/teaching contexts.
- Use social media, projects and collaborative tasks to improve the application CLILbased curricula.
- Work through pupils' motivation and re-negotiation of curricula to pursue the double goal language and content.

Target Group

This course is addressed to primary and secondary teachers who want to adopt and/or improve CLIL methodology in their lessons and also to teachers, school directors, school inspectors, school staff in general who want to work in a CLIL-based educational context.

Language of course

This course will be provided in English. It is requested to all participants to have a level of English enough to understand the trainer and to interact and participate actively in the course.

The course can also be provided in Italian, French and Spanish.

Methodology

The course is based on an active and participative learning/teaching approach with theoretical exposition of the contents along with practical tools that allow the integration and dynamization of all of the work group.

Participants are, since the beginning, encouraged to interact with each other during the classes and through a specific blog which will be specifically created for the course. Slides and documents presented during the lessons will be uploaded on the same blog.





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Participants will create active discussions with their colleagues and receive feedback from the expert course tutors.

The course comprises 4 interactive learning modules, from Monday to Thursday, plus a visit to a Valencian school on Friday, where is possible to see Spanish way of working as well as exchange good practices with other teachers. Last day of the course, it is also foreseen an evaluation and certificate issuing session.

Programme

Day 1 – 4 hours

What does CLIL really mean?

- Welcome meeting. Presentation of programme. Presentation of participants and sharing expectations
- Knowing participants and their students.
- Setting up their expectations and introducing CLIL through curricula (renegotiation)
- City Tour 1 extra hour.

Day 2 – 4 hours

Can I become a good CLIL teacher?

- How to improve flexibility and apply the tri-articulation of CLIL.
- How to prepare and propose motivational CLIL activities: planning CLIL lessons and didactic units
- How to collaborate with colleagues and teach collaboration to the pupils (coworking strategies)

Day 3 – 4 hours

What is my goal in a CLIL lesson?

- How to adapt syllabus and curricula to the context
- How to use ICT tools to facilitate and support teaching through CLIL
- How to balance language, content and (meta)cognition

Day 4 – 4 hours

Ok, now I am a CLIL teacher

- Practical tools and strategies to improve articulated targets
- Role play CLIL teachers in action
- Discussion, feedbacks and auto- and self-evaluation





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Day 5 – 4 hours

Professional visit, Evaluation, Certification and Farewell

- Visiting a school in Valencia
- Meeting with teachers and students
- Evaluation and certification
- Farewell lunch 3 extra hours approximately
