



ICT FOR TEACHING AND LEARNING

Objectives

The main objectives of this course are:

- Provide teachers with practical ideas on how they can incorporate technology into their existing lessons
- Defining ICT usage in education with its pros and cons
- Sharing good practices in teaching and learning, using ICT, enabling teachers to become confident and competent enough to create a collaborative, interactive classroom experience for their students using the ICT
- Familiarize teachers with current trends in the use of Internet and new technologies in education
- Exchanging experiences in cooperative and collaborative learning process as long as in creativity and innovation
- Introducing gamification and the use of videogames with learning purposes

Target Group

The training course is addressed to primary and secondary school teachers, adult teachers, school directors, school inspectors, VET teachers, VET trainers, managers of enterprises and officers working in public bodies and schools in general who wish to acquire the skills for using ICT with educational purposes.

Language of course

This course will be provided in English. It is requested to all participants to have a level of English enough to understand the trainer and to interact and participate actively in the course.

Methodology

The course will consist of theoretical and practical blended sessions. Each session will be organized into 3 main parts:

1st Part: Hands on ICT!

The participants will try some of the ICT tools that will be presented during the session

2nd Part: Step by step

Teachers will learn how to create and use them, step by step

3rd Part

After the break, teachers can do more practice on some of the tools that have been presented in order to experiment what has been used and shown previously.



The tutor will monitor and help all the participants in this practical session.

All the material presented during each session will be shared with the participants on a G-Classroom, where will be also shared the activities that all the participants will be carrying out during the course.

In order to sort out common doubts, they will also have a forum and a Class Diary to track each session.

The programme will be adapted considering the participants real needs and interests. We will send a G-form to collect participants' previous knowledge on the ICT tools that will be presented, in order to adapt the course more to their real needs. - First steps to create a Breakout edu or Digital Escape Room
- Genially (presentations, videos, videogames and break-out edu)
- Canva (timeline, posters, videos)
- G-Forms (to create Quiz Surveys, and online Digital lock)

Day 5 – 4 hours

Professional visit, Evaluation, Certification and Farewell

- Evaluation and certification
- Farewell activity
