

#### KA1 ERASMUS+ COURSES FOR TEACHERS AND TRAINERS ROMA COMMUNITY: PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE IN EDUCATION AND SOCIAL PROGRESS

- Theme 6: European education projects for Roma community TERNO, SEDRIN and MATRIX.
- Web and resources.
- Practical activity.
- Theme 7: Roma associations.
- Case studies. Group work.
- Self-evaluation.

### Day 5 – 5 hours Professional Visit

- Professional visit to Roma Community Centre/Association
- Meeting with the service users and community workers.
