- Get familiar with the fundamental pillars of inclusive methodologies for students with special needs.
- Understand the concept of functionality, as well as the paradigm and models that promote it.
- Analyse and reflect on the different pedagogical models of inclusive education, as well as the adequacy of these to the different educational plans of the schools.
- Exchange good practices and experiences with other teachers from different nationalities.

Target group

The training course is addressed to primary and secondary school teachers, VET teachers, VET trainers, adults' teachers, managers, and employees of enterprises as well as social and youth workers of non-profit organization and public entities.

Language of course

This course will be provided in English. It is requested to all participants to have a level of English enough to understand the trainer and to interact and participate actively in the course.

Methodology

The approach used is highly practical and based on the previous professional experiences that trainer has been accumulating in this field.

The course combines learning by doing methodologies with the transmission of contents and requires the active participation of the group in order to achieve the most satisfactory results.

It is foreseen 4 days of practical lessons and 1 day of visit to a school or organisation dealing with the subjects of the course. Moments of socialisation have been also foreseen.
