- Design Inspiring Learning Situations: Craft innovative, AI-enhanced lessons that align with Bloom's Taxonomy and the legislation of your country.

Target Group

The training course is addressed to primary and secondary school teachers, VET teachers, VET trainers, adults' teachers, managers, and employees of enterprises as well as social and youth workers of non-profit organization and public entities.

Language of course

This course will be conducted in English. All participants are expected to have a sufficient level of English to understand the trainer and to engage actively in discussions and activities.

Methodology

This course offers a hands-on, practical approach to integrating Al into your teaching. We'll move beyond theory to explore real-world applications, ethical considerations, and powerful tools. The methodology is based on:

- Learning by Doing: You'll actively use AI tools, experiment with prompts, and create resources you can use immediately.
- Collaborative Exploration: We'll share best practices, discuss challenges, and learn from each other's experiences.
- Focus on Practicality: The course emphasizes tools and techniques that can be directly applied in diverse educational settings.

- ✓ Adapt and personalize the prompt engineering and the AI content-creating for different learning styles and needs, guided by DUA principles.
- ✓ Analyze and modify didactic materials using AI
